Thank you for your letter and your questions about the process by which western Alaskan villages select boards of directors under the Community Development Quota (CDQ) program. I appreciate your concern about the need for meaningful village participation in the CDQ program.

In 1992, I helped establish the CDQ program to promote fisheries related economic development in Western Alaska. Over the years, I have worked to strengthen and stabilize the program.

As you know, the statutory language does not specifically address many of the issues you have raised. I understand that NOAA has been working on regulations to further define eligibility requirements for boards of directors. My staff and I will continue to follow this process and I will keep your comments in mind, should Congress modify administrative aspects of the CDQ program.
